

Medical Illnesses Form

Youth medical illnesses (ongoing or past history) diagnosed by physicians were assessed using the rater-administered Medical Illnesses form (Weisberg, et al., 2002). For this study, the Medical Illnesses form was adapted to assess for select medical conditions associated with substance use disorders (Saitz, 2009). The Medical Illnesses form has been used with psychiatric samples (Weisberg, et al., 2002).
